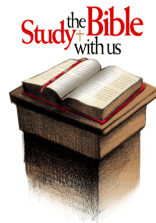

The Lord's Feast

The consequences of sin can be devastating. Sin costs a lot. It is like a big bully beating on a little guy refusing to quit. Those consequences can linger for days or even years. The man in John 5 has been paralyzed for 38 years as a result of his sin. Jesus came by and asked him, "Do you want to be made well?"

The legend of the pool was that an angel would come from heaven, stir the water, and the first one into the pool would be healed. So, he answered Jesus, "I have no one to put me into the pool when the water is stirred." Jesus healed him.

"No one to help me," he said, reminds me of King David's psalm 142:4 "no one cares for me." How lonely one feels when he thinks that there is no one on his side; that no one cares. Jesus looked at this man's heart and saw a glow, a spark, something alive in his life that needed healing. Jesus fixed it and concluded his remarks to him by saying, "See, you have been made well!
